

Terms of Reference

Peace Regional Emergency Management Partnership (PREMP)

A Regional Emergency Response Collaboration in the Peace River Region.

The Peace River Region has established a collaborative emergency response group to enhance preparedness and support among municipalities. In the event of a large-scale incident that exceeds the capabilities of a single municipality's Incident Command Post (ICP), surrounding municipalities may help by deploying trained personnel to help fill vacant roles and responsibilities.

This mutual aid support is contingent on the availability of resources within the responding municipalities. Compensation for services rendered will be managed under the Northwest Emergency Response Agreement.

Additionally, the group will pursue regional training opportunities, enabling personnel from participating municipalities to train together and enhance collective response capabilities. Expenses for staff attending training sessions will be covered through grants or municipal funding.

To further strengthen emergency preparedness, the group will compile and share potential resource lists that may be needed during an incident. This will help ensure that municipalities have access to essential equipment, supplies, and personnel when responding to emergencies.

The signed list of municipal Directors of Emergency Management or authorized designate listed below will review this document each year and update as needed.

This initiative fosters regional cooperation and ensures that municipalities can efficiently support one another in times of need.
