<p><b>PURPOSE OF THIS POLICY:</b> To regulate the usage of the portable corrals.</p>		
<p><b>POLICY STATEMENT:</b></p> <p>The Municipal District of Peace No. 135 will allow usage of the portable corrals by the following organizations, at no charge:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Local 4-H Beef Clubs</li> <li>- Agricultural Societies operating within the Municipal boundaries.</li> <li>- Registered Societies or Associations operating within Municipal boundaries.</li> </ul> <p>Should a conflict arise over dates of usage, the organization first requesting usage shall be given priority.</p> <p>The corrals will be stored at the municipal yard in Berwyn when not in use.</p> <p>Users may take the corrals one day prior to their own event and must return the corrals to the municipal yard on the day following their event, excepting where usage has been arranged by more than one user for successive days, in which case the first user may deliver corrals to the second user.</p> <p>Users are responsible for any damages incurred as a result of their usage or transportation. All damages are to be reported to the office staff or Manager of Agricultural Services upon return of the corrals. Corrals will be inspected upon their return</p> <p>The Municipality will provide a trailer for storage and hauling of the corrals. The corrals are to be transported using this trailer.</p> <p>The corrals may be rented to residents of the MD of Peace, MD of Fairview or Clear Hills County at a rate listed in the current Fees and Charges Bylaw, subject to priority use by the 4-H Clubs.</p> <p>This policy was APPROVED by Council on June 25<sup>th</sup>, 2024, by Motion #275/24.</p>
