<b>PURPOSE OF THIS POLICY:</b> To allow the attachment of telecommunications equipment to municipal infrastructure and privately-owned infrastructure within municipal rights-of-way.		
<b>POLICY STATEMENT:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The Municipal district of Peace No. 135 (MD) will allow telecommunication companies to attach equipment to municipal infrastructure and/or privately-owned infrastructure within municipal road rights-of-way, and to municipal facilities under the following guidelines:           <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) the Federation of Canadian Municipalities / Canadian Wireless Telecommunications Association Antenna System Siting Protocol Template that aligns with the federal government’s Canada’s Antenna Siting Policy shall be followed.</li> <li>b) the telecommunication company acknowledges the role of the Municipal District in its land-use authority as outlined in the Template and in Innovation, Science and Economic Development Canada’s CPC-2-0-03 Issue 4.</li> <li>c) all applicable municipal, provincial, and federal standards shall be followed.</li> </ol> </li> <li>2. Requests for attaching telecommunication equipment to municipal infrastructure must have the prior approval of Council. The telecommunication carrier requesting such attachment shall sign a Licence Agreement and meet all responsibilities outlined in that Agreement and any permits required for the telecommunication attachment.</li> <li>3. The applicant must also conduct public consultation as deemed necessary by the MD.</li> </ol> <p>This policy was APPROVED by Council on October 8, 2024 by Motion #424/24</p>
