

**BYLAW NO. 4/2026  
MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF PEACE NO. 135  
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA**

A Bylaw of the Municipal District of Peace No. 135, Province of Alberta, to provide for the designations required under the *Access to Information Act* and *Protection of Privacy Act*.

**WHEREAS** pursuant to Section 98(a) of the *Access to Information Act* and Chapter A – 1.4, the Municipal District of Peace No. 135 must designate a person or group of persons as the Head of the Municipality for the Act;

**AND WHEREAS** pursuant to Section 98(b) of the *Access to Information Act* and Chapter A – 1.4, the Municipal District of Peace No. 135 may set fees payable to the Municipality for services provided under the Act and Regulations;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Municipal District of Peace No. 135, Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts:

**1. Title**

1.1 This Bylaw shall be cited as "*Access to Information Act and Protection of Privacy Act*".

**2. Purpose**

2.1 The purpose of the Bylaw is to establish the administrative structure of the Municipal District of Peace No. 135 in relation to the *Access to Information Act* and the *Protection of Privacy Act*, and to set fees thereunder.

**3. Definitions**

3.1 "Act" means the *Access to Information Act*, Chapter A – 1.4.

3.2 "Applicant" means a person who makes a request for access to a record under Section 7(1) of the *Access to Information Act*.

3.3 "Municipality" means Municipal District of Peace No. 135.

**4. Designated Head**

4.1 For the purpose of the *Access to Information Act* and the *Protection of Privacy Act*, the Administrative Officer is designated as the Head.

**5. Fees**

5.1 Where an Applicant is required to pay a fee for services, the fee payable is in accordance with the *Access to Information Act* Regulation 133/2025 as amended from time to time or any successor Regulation that sets fees for requests for information from the Province.

**6. Repeal**

Bylaw No. 6/99 is hereby repealed.

This bylaw shall come into force and effect on the date of its final passing.


